

BAUXITE HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1965

VOCATIONAL/TECHNICAL/CAREER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Bauxite Class of 1965 has established a scholarship to be awarded to a Bauxite High School graduating senior who desires to further his or her education by enrolling in an approved vocational, technical or career education college or institute instead of a traditional four year college or university. All applicants must have a minimum grade point average of 2.0. The recipient must enroll as a full time student in an on campus program designed for completion in two years or less. This scholarship may not be used for programs serving as stepping stones for entrance into conventional four year educational institutions. One scholarship will be awarded each school year and will be funded at the rate of \$500 per semester. Funding may be continued at the same rate for a total of four semesters, provided that the recipient maintains a 2.5 grade point average and remains in good standing with their selected institution. This scholarship is to be awarded based on the student's desire, ability, financial need and ties to the community. The application deadline is April 15.

APPLICATIONS ARE AVALIABLE IN THE COUNSELOR'S OFFICE

Any information obtained in this application process will be treated with the strictest of confidence and will only be used in helping to determine the most qualified and deserving recipient from all the applicants. Please complete the entire application following these instructions. Thank you for your cooperation.

Qualifications:

- 1. Applicant must be a current year Bauxite graduating senior
- 2. Applicant must have a 2.0 GPA during the most recent five semesters
- 3. Applicant must complete an application form
- 4. Applicant must submit faculty and community recommendations
- 5. Applicant must intend to enroll in an approved Vocational/Career Education Institution taking at least 12 credit hours of on campus instruction

Funding:

- 1. Funding shall be at the rate of \$500 per semester \$1000 per year
- 2. Payment will be made jointly to the recipient and their selected institution
- 3. Recipient must maintain a 2.5 GPA or better for continued funding
- 4. Recipient must remain in good standing with the selected institution for continued funding
- 5. Recipient must request continued funding each semester, up to a total of four semesters.

Procedure:

These items are to be mailed to the Class of '65 Scholarship Committee in a 9x12 envelope:

- 1. Completed and signed application form, two pages
- 2. Three recommendation forms, in their own envelopes
- 3. High School transcript showing courses taken and grades achieved during the past five semesters
- 4. All applications must be postmarked no later than April 15, in order to be considered.

This complete application packet must be placed in a 9x12 envelope and mailed, or delivered in person, to the address below no later than April 15. Any applications with late postmarks will be returned unopened.

Scholarship Application Instructions

General Instructions

Please provide the information requested on the next two pages of this application packet. Type or print plainly on the next page and complete the short essay items on the final page in your own handwriting. You may print if you prefer. Select three people who know you to fill out personal reference forms on your behalf. They are to seal their completed forms in an envelope before returning them to you. Place these reference forms, your two completed pages of the application, and your transcript in a 9x12 envelope and mail to the committee no later than April 15.

Personal Information

Name ----- Your first, middle and last name

Phone number ----- Phone number where you may be contacted

Address ----- Current mailing address

Parents' names ----- Give their full names

Occupations ----- List type of work (truck driver, nurse, teacher, firefighter, unemployed, retired, etc)

Number of children ----- Give the total number of children who live in your household, including yourself.

Ages ----- Give the age of each child living in your household

Household income ----- This should include all income of your parents (wages, self employment, retirement).

Circle or underline the choice which best describes your family's income.

Course of study ------ What career do you plan to pursue? (welder, nurse, hair dresser, mechanic, etc)

School selected ----- Which school have you chosen to attend?

School and Community Activities

Put together a list of activities that have been an important part of your life up to this point. These activities may include anything - school, community, or family situations. Now rearrange those activities in their order of importance to you, and list the top eight on the application.

Recommendation Forms

Remove the three recommendation forms on the back of this packet, print your name at the top of each form, and give them to three people of your choosing. At least two of these forms are to be completed by school personnel. Those people may be teachers, administrators, bus drivers, custodians, or anyone else employed by the Bauxite School District. The third form may be given to anyone who knows about you and your character. This could include an employer, your pastor, baseball coach, a third school employee, or anyone of your choosing. Each recommendation form should include an envelope so that it can be sealed and returned to you by the person completing the form. This process is to insure privacy to the person making the recommendation.

This completed application packet must be mailed, or hand delivered as directed above, no later than April15.
