Bauxite Ladies Association Scholarship

The general nature and purpose of the Bauxite Ladies Association Scholarship program is to assist a deserving graduate, preferably a female, at Bauxite High School who has shown an aptitude for higher educational training and will be attending an accredited institution of higher learning in the state of Arkansas. It is open to students who are descendants of parents, grandparents, great-grandparents, etc., (who attended Bauxite High School or has Bauxite Ancestry Connection)* and need financial assistance with their education. ***Omission of this information will result in disqualification!**

One Scholarship, in the amount of \$1,200.00, will be given and shall be paid in two installments: at the beginning of each semester to the student's school. The recipient will be considered on these factors:

1. Scholarship applicant must rank in the upper one-half of the class and must have completed Seven semesters of the standard four-year high school course in Bauxite High School. (30%)
2. Financial Need (45%).
3. Moral Character 4. Leadership 5. Extra-Curricular Activities and Community Service (25%).

Students desiring to be considered for the scholarship must submit typed requests for consideration to the Scholarship Committee for the Bauxite Ladies Association through the Principal and/or Counselor of Bauxite High School on or before **April 19, 2023**.

Requests should contain a brief history of the applicant indicating, among other things, school and community activities, honors and extra-curricular activities, the name (s) of Bauxite High School descendants; name, address, and occupation of the applicant's parents and the front page of parents income tax form stating their AGI (adjusted gross income); Three letters of recommendation from adults not connected with the Bauxite School System or a Relative, the letters may cover applicant's ability, work habits, integrity, and potential; A picture, and A brief description about the course of study the student plans to pursue.

The requests **must** also be supported by the following from the Counselor, Principal or Superintendent of Bauxite High School:

1. A certificate indicating that the applicant ranks in the upper one-half of the class.
2. A seven semester transcript of the applicant's grades and credits.

The Guidance Office will collect all applications and then notify the scholarship chairman, who will gather them, April 19, 2023 for the committee to review. Each entry will then be submitted to a panel of Judges who are not connected to Bauxite.

The recipient of the scholarship will be named by the committee at the May, 2023 Senior Awards Night at Bauxite High School. The Scholarship Committee may, in its discretion, withdraw from any scholarship holder the benefits of the scholarship if it is deemed by the Committee that the holder of said scholarship is not worthy of its benefits.
